Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, W. E. Tarrant, Annie Tarrant Eskew and J. W. Tarrant

on or about the 20th day of January, in the year of
 our Lord one thousand and thirty, exhibited their complaint in the Court
 of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against
Will Tinsley, et al.

Demanding recovery of the real estate described in the complaint and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 23rd
January 1930 and such proceedings were had thereon as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
 adjudged and ordered that the said real estate aforesaid mentioned and described be conveyed by E. Inman,
 Master in and for the County aforesaid, to T. A. Mahaffey and Bessie B. Mahaffey -
 in the sum of money recovered in the said cause, to wit, \$653.33, to be paid to the said Court, and the same will appear in the Judgment Roll No. 145.
 And it is further ordered and directed that the said Plaintiff, E. Inman, do grant, convey and release unto the said
T. A. Mahaffey and Bessie B. Mahaffey, all the right, title and interest of the
 minor Defendants, Mary Lee Walker, Jas. W. Tinsley, Woodrow Tinsley, Dorcas Tinsley,
Willie Tinsley, Helen Tinsley, Henry Tinsley and Joel C. Tinsley, in and to the following
 described real estate:

All that tract of land situate in Greenville County on the Golden Grove Creek
 containing 110 acres, more or less: Beginning at a black oak and running thence N. 43
 E. 28.65 chs. to a stake corner; thence S. 47 E. 38.65 chs. to a stake corner on
 Benjamin Tarrant's line; thence S. 43 W. 28.65 chs. to a Spanish Oak; thence N. 47 W.
 38.65 chs. to a post oak stake; thence to the beginning corner. Being the same tract of
 land conveyed to Columbus E. Tarrant by W. W. Tarrant by deed dated December 5, 1883 and
 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 145, at Page 418.
