"All that certain tract of land in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 265 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as Tract No. 6, according to a subdivision and plat of the estate of Jesse L. French, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers in April, 1930. Said tract of land is bounded by lands of J. P. Whitte, W. M. Clotworthy, Reeves and Tracts Nos. 4, 5, and 7 of the plat above mentioned and has such metes and bounds and courses and distances as will appear by reference to the above plat, which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "3", Page 270."

The above tract of land represents the divided interest of the grantee, as fixed by the Court, in the Partition Suit herein, under which this deed is made.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.
