TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, B. B. Henson and Annie May Fisher

on or about the 8th day of July in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Syda Pearl Henson et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th day of July 1930, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Nettie Belle Henson

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. \_\_\_\_\_) NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Nettie Belle Henson, the following described real estate:

"All that certain tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 50 acres, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by a survey and plat made by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, March 10, 1930, to-wit:  
Beginning at a pin in the center of the Jordan Road and running thence S. 87.30 W. 13.30 along the line of the Neely land to a pine stump; thence S. 57.16.20 thence S. 30 W. 4.56 to a black gum; thence S. 12.30 E. 12.70 to a stone in or near road; thence S. 73.6.15.60 to a stone; thence N. 6.6.16.90 to an iron pin in or near road; thence N. 88. E. 7.10 to an iron pin; thence N. 26.30 W. 10.20 to a stake; thence N. 27.30 E. 9.12 to an iron pin in the center of the Jordan Road; thence along the center of said road N. 31 W. 4.36 to the beginning."  
The above land was devised to the grantee herein under Item 3 of the will of her father, W. F. Henson.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Nettie Belle Henson, her heirs and assigns forever.
