TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, *C. Luman*,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:
AHEARAS, *Carrie Hawthorne*.

In or about the 2nd day of February, in the year of 1931, exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, or the County aforesaid against Carrie Hawthorne, minor 17 years of age.

Defendant came into the Court wherefore defendant to the complaint, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 2nd March 1931, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court whereby it was ordered and directed that the estate aforesaid mentioned and described be conveyed by C. Luman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Carrie Hawthorne.

Defendant mentioned in the said decree to be defendant thereto in the said Court will appear. See Judgment Roll No. 1931.

He has been duly paid and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Carrie Hawthorne,

all the undivided one-sixth (1/6) interest of Annie Lee Hawthorne, deceased in and to the following described real estate, to-wit: Carrie Hawthorne that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Green Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being the lot of land purchased by Annie Lee Sloane from J. B. Sloan on September 10, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. B. Office for Greenville County in Vol. #1, Page 128, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: beginning at a stake 3x on Green Avenue and running thence S. 07 E. 435' 6" to a stake 3x and running stake 3x, thence N. 65 W. 99' 4" to a stake 3x on Green Avenue, corner, and being a part of the lot of land conveyed to J. B. Martin by C. B. Dryer by deed bearing date of February 26, 1905 and recorded in R. M. B. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 555, Page 253.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, fully claiming from, under, or by any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said

Carrie Hawthorne, her

heirs and assigns forever.
