has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto C. H. Tally, his heirs  
and assigns -

all those four certain lots or parcels of land situate  
in the County and State aforesaid, known and  
designated as lots nos. 31, 32, 33 and 34, on Plat  
of Alta Vista, property of the K. T. R. Land  
Development Company, recorded in the  
Office of C. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat  
Book 9, lot page 120, and more particularly  
described on said plat as follows:

Lot no. 31 & 32: Beginning at a point, joint  
corner of Crescent and Fairview Avenue and  
running thence N. 82° 00' W. 148.6 feet to corner  
of lot 32, thence along the line of lots nos.  
31 and 32, S. 8° 00' W. 200 feet to corner on lot no.  
33; thence along the line of lot no. 33, S.  
82° 0 E. 162.1 feet to point on alley, thence N.  
4° 15' E. 200.4 feet to the beginning corner  
of lot 33; Beginning at a point, joint corner  
of lots 31 and 32, due running thence S. 4° 15' W.  
126.6 feet to point thence crossing branch  
N. 50° 56' W. 118 feet to point thereof N. 73° 09' W.  
70.3 ft. to corner on lot no. 34; thence N. 8° 00' E.  
54.6 ft. to rear corner of lot no. 31; thence  
along the rear line of lots nos. 31 and 32 S.  
82° 0 E. 162.1 feet to the beginning corner includ-  
ing 20 foot alley as shown from plat at  
lots 31 and 32.

Lot no. 34: Beginning at a point, joint corner  
of Fairview Avenue and Oliver Street and  
running thence S. 86° 40' E. 175 ft. to corner on lot  
no. 36; thence along the line of lot 36 N. 4° 15'  
E. 66.5 ft. to corner of lot no. 35; thence along  
the line of lot no. 35 N. 85° 40' W. 175 ft. to  
point on Fairview Avenue; thence along the  
eastern side of Fairview Avenue, S. 4° 15' W. 66.5  
feet to the beginning corner.

Also the rear portion of a 20 foot alley as  
shown on said plat separating lots nos.  
32, 33 and 34, with the exception of 100 feet  
of said Alley measured from the intersection  
of said Alley with Oliver Street. It  
being the intention of said grantor, to retain  
said Alley a distance of 100 feet from the  
intersection of said Oliver Street and said Alley  
the portion of said Alley herein intended to  
be conveyed is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the western line of  
lot nos. 36, 100 feet from the northwestern corner  
of said Alley and Oliver Street, and running  
thence S. 4° 15' W. approximately 100 feet to  
southern property line of the Development;  
thence along the line of said Development  
N. 50° 56' W. approximately 22 feet to the

southeastern corner of lot no. 35; thence along the  
line of lot nos. 33 N. 4° 15' E. approximately 190 feet  
to point on line of lot no. 33, thence S. 82° 10' E.  
20 feet to the requiring

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee..... hereinabove named, and his

grantee..... hereinabove named, and his

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
