KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. J. Sullivan, Marshall Sullivan, Miss Lydia C. Sullivan, and Mrs. Evaline S. Whiting of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of one hundred and other valuable Dollars to me in hand paid by the SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of about three (3) miles from

Greenville County Court House and lying in the forks of the Augusta Road and the Kirklin Mill Road, and being the property inherited by us from our mother, Mrs. Emma C. Sullivan, deceased

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power of electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power line, with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said line and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same. It is provided, that any time in the future

in the development of the said property, poles that may be located hereunder should be in the way of a proposed driveway or street, the grantee herein will move the same, at its expense, within a reasonable time after written request of the grantor or his assigns, so that no further expense or delay shall be occasioned to the grantor or his assigns by reason of the location of said poles.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. W. A. Chandler of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Sullivan, Eagle, Jurdal, and

Chandler, on the Augusta Road, about three miles from Greenville Court House, said line to be run along the Augusta Road, and near the Southern boundary between said W. A. Chandler, and the Jurdal and Eagle lands, same being for the purpose of joining the line running from Parkers Mill Road through the Eagle property to Augusta Road

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power of electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power line, with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said line and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same.
