KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, James Langford of Bates  
Grove, heir, Greenville, Pa., do

In the State aforesaid,  
In consideration of the sum of  
One Dollar (\$1.00) and DOLLARS,  
and other considerations

to ... in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Greenville and Northern Railway  
Company, a corporation

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Greenville and Northern Railway Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, a strip or parcel of land situated, lying and being in  
the State of what is now known as Langford  
Grove, of the railroad belonging to the within  
named grantee, in Bates Groveship, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a poplar on the North Bank of  
the branch or stream that flows under the said  
Langford Grove, 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet from the center of the said  
tree, thence North 200 feet to a point, thence in  
a northwesterly direction to a point on the right of  
way of the said Greenville and Northern Railway  
Company, 37 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet West of the center of the North End  
of the said Langford Grove, the said distance more  
or less, however, this point is on the line of the  
said right of way as conveyed in that certain  
Deed, M. & G. Langford to Greenville and Knoxville Rail  
way Company, dated May 1, 1906, and recorded  
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South  
Carolina, in Vol. of Deeds, S.S., page 682, thence said  
along the line of the said right of way to  
the intersection of said line with the Branch  
which flows under the said Langford Grove, thence  
with the meanderings of the said Branch in a  
southwesterly direction to the beginning point, a poplar,  
said parcel of land to contain about four acres (4)  
acre, more or less.

The above described land conveyed to the  
said Greenville and Northern Railway Company as  
herein described to be used for railroad use and  
purposes, provided, however, that unless the said  
grantee shall cause to be constructed a fill at  
the said Langford Grove within a period of five  
(5) years from the date hereof, then, and in  
that event this deed to become null and void,  
and the said strip or parcel of land herein con  
veyed shall revert to the within named grantee  
her heirs and assigns.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appur  
tenant.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Greenville and Northern Railway Company, its  
heirs and assigns, forever.

AND

I myself and my  
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said  
Greenville and Northern Railway Company, its  
heirs and assigns, against  
myself and my  
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
