the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Rush Realty Company a Corporation, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that lot of land situate near the north west intersection of Buncombe and Lawrence Streets, in the City and County of Greenville South Carolina, designated as lot no. 17 on plat of Rush Brothers, as shown by R. E. Dalton Plat, January, 1924, and more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on Buncombe Street at corner of lot no. 16, which is at the western edge of a seven inch brick wall, and runs thence along said edge of said wall n. 20.04 e. 73.5 feet; thence n. 69.07 w. 20 feet; thence s. 29.04 w. 59.58 feet on Buncombe Street at a drill hole, thence s. 34.30 e. 24.53 feet to beginning corner.
