NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-eight hundred twenty-five (\$2825.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said George Norwood

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

George Norwood and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township; Beginning at an iron pin on left side of Brushy Creek Road, running thence S. 26-5/8 W. 475 feet to a willow tree; thence S. 22-1/2 E. 278 feet to stake in branch; thence S. 17-7/8 W. 266 feet to a water oak; thence S. 1.00 E. 133 feet to a poplar; thence N. 86-1/2 W. 207 feet to a stone; thence S. 57-1/2 W. 151 feet to a sour wood tree; thence N. 58-1/2 W. 693 feet to a stake; thence N. 24-1/2 E. 2079 feet to a stake in center of Enoree River; thence with center of said river to center of bridge on said road; thence with said road 139 feet; thence S. 22.5 W. 358 feet to an angle in said road; thence S. 86.5 feet to the beginning, containing 47.03 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Greenville Holding Company by A.H.
