the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

H. E. Lhamblee, and his heirs and assigns for-  
ever, the following described real estate:  
"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land  
being and lying in the State and County  
aforesaid on the north side of Main Street,  
in Fountain Inn, S. C., bounded by lot of H. E.  
Jones, Mrs. Harry Stames, being 33 1/2 feet wide  
on Main Street and running back 150 feet  
to an alley; this being the same lot deed-  
ed to Weldon Holland by R. B. Holland Decem-  
ber 11, 1915, and recorded in the office of  
R. M. C. for Greenville County, Dec. 9, 1918, Vol.  
44, Page 290."
