the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

R. D. Dobson and B. P. Edwards and their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that lot of land situate, in the County and State aforesaid, in or near the City of Greer, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at the corner of Geo. Amleys lot and running thence with his line easterly to Church line; thence along this line to line of E. Inman's estate; thence along the line of this estate to Earl Street; thence with Street 60 feet to the beginning corner; being one half (1/2) of that lot of land conveyed by deed of E. Inman to Etta McManis in deed bearing date October 3, 1918, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County of Greenville, in Vol. 134, at Page 128."
