the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Robert Bryson and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land being and lying in the State and County aforesaid, containing forty seven and 8/100 acres, more or less, with the following metes and bounds, to wit: Bounded by Jones Mill Road, S. Gault, J. M. Gault and others; Beginning at Jones Mill Road at S. Gault's corner and running thence N. 61 1/2° E. 46.54' to stake, thence S. 21 1/2° W. 11.35' to stake, thence S. 61 1/2° W. 47.15' to center of Jones Mill Road; thence with said road N. 62° 10' 42" to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land conveyed to C.
