the following described real estate:
"All that piece of land or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid, in
Greenville Township, near Monaghan Mills being
known and designated as Lot No. 13, in Block "Y",
of the subdivision known as Kinnerside, plat of
same recorded in Plat Book "A", Page 323, and
having the following metes and bounds, to-
wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side
of Highlaw Ave. at corner of lot no. 12, 100
feet east of Marion Street, and running
thence with Highlaw Ave. S. 79-45 to 50 feet
