the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Bank of Piedmont, S.C. a corporation, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situated and being in Groves Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone corner at the most southerly corner of Tract 4 B, and runs thence N. 48-20 W. 987.37 feet to a stone; thence S. 39-46 E. 973.8 feet to a point in the Piedmont Road; thence S. 62-25 E. 819.3 feet to a point, with the center of the road leading from the Piedmont Road to said point; thence along the center of the road N. 49-51 E. 1007.2 feet to a point; thence leaving said road and following along the above mentioned Tract 4 B, N. 45-31 W. 741.4 feet to a stake; thence with along same, N. 82-07 W. 945-17 feet to the point or place of beginning, containing 45-47 acres, more or less, according to a survey made February 1920, by Patrick Terry Company, Engineers, Greenville, S.C. and being known as Tract 4 B, and that made by said Engineers on a plat recorded Plat Book 207, C, Office, Greenville County, S.C.
