Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars,
to me paid by the said Nell M. Barr


the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
the said

Nell M. Barr and her heirs and assigns
forever, the following described real estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of
land situate, lying and being in Paris
Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid,
said, on Paris Mountain and adjoining
and just above a certain lot of land now
or formerly owned by Westwell, beginning
at a point on the Mountain Road 66 feet
from the corner of Westwells lot and in
the middle of lot formerly belonging to Ella
D. Barr, and thence running with said
Road S. 36 1/2 E. 66 feet to Westwells corner;
thence with Westwells lot N. 55 1/4 E. 255.42
feet to a corner; thence to the rear corner
of lot now or formerly of Ella D. Barr N.
33 1/4 W. 82 feet 6 inches; thence in a straight
