City of Greenville, in Ward One, on Wilton Street, and  
occupying the following meter, bounds, courses and

266 feet from Park Avenue (formerly Carver Street)  
and running thence S. 76° E. 186 feet to a 14-foot  
alley; thence with said alley N. 4° W. 58 feet to the
