WHEREAS B. H. Henson and Annie May Fisher

on or about the 8th day of July in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Hyda Pearl Henson, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th day of July 1930, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five Hundred (\$7500.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said B. H. Henson

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. H. Henson, the following described real estate:

all that certain tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and known and designated as Tract No. 3 of the estate of W. T. Henson, according to a subdivision and plat of same, made by W. P. Morrow, in March 1930, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by said plat, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Jordan Road and in line of Lot No. 4 and at corner of Lot No. 2 of said estate, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 2 S. 87.30 W. 9.12 to stake in line of said Lot No. 2; thence continuing along the line of Lot No. 2, S. 26.30 E. 10.20 to pin; thence S. 1.30 E. 11.70 to an iron pin; thence N. 54 E. 17.10 to pin in the Jordan Road; thence in a southeasterly direction along said road 2.06 to a pin at corner of the said lot; thence N. 68.34 E. 3.90 to stake; thence S. 42 E. 5.18 to pin; thence N. 82 E. 4.62 to pin at corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of this lot N. 12 W. 13.20 to stake; thence continuing along the line of this lot N. 42 W. 12.50 to stake in line of Lot No. 4; thence S. 58.30 W. 1.20 to a stake; thence continuing along the line of Lot No. 4 S. 50 W. 12.50 to a point in line of the Jordan Road; thence along the line of said road N. 31 W. 1.82 to the beginning corner and continuing 45.81 acres, more or less, and is known as the same place of the said W. T. Henson. Also: All that certain tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 29.54 acres, more or less, on Public Road leading from Greel and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by a subdivision and plat of the W.
