nine hundred (\$900.00)
to me paid by the said Helen Fisher Dollars,

the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
the said Helen Fisher, the following described real estate:

"all that tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville
County, South Carolina, known and designated as lot
no. 6 of the property of the W. S. Henson estate, according
to a plat and subdivision, made by W. G. Morrow,
Surveyor, in March, 1930, containing 30 acres, more
