the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

Lula Jordan Willis, the following described real estate:-

on the Styke Mill Road, and having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a white oak running
