the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

Robt. S. Woodside, the following described real estate:  
"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated,  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of  
Greenville and described by metes and bounds, as follows,  
to-wit: Beginning at a beech 34.0 m on Reedy Fork Creek, and  
running thence S. 68 1/2 W. 47.30 chains to a red oak (gone) and  
a stone 10 m; thence S. 27 1/2 W. 46.60 chains to a stone 7 m. (old  
pointers); thence S. 62 1/3 E. 54.50 chains to a stone 34 7/8 m.;  
thence N. 7 W. 27.74 chains to a stone 34 7/8 m.; thence N. 45 1/4 E.  
24.45 chains to a birch 37.7 m on Reedy Fork Creek; thence  
along the meanders of said creek to the beginning corner, con-
