

(owing to the relocation of James Street, May 4, 1915, the point of beginning is now 373.2 feet north from the present corner of James Street).

Subject however to the lien of a certain mortgage bearing date the 7th day of May, 1925 given by the grantor herein to Pioneer Life Insurance Company to secure payment of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) with interest at seven per cent (7%) per annum which the grantor herein assumes and agrees to pay.

Together with all and singular the right, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said The Salvation Army, the grantor herein, its successors and assigns forever.

This conveyance is made pursuant to an order of the Supreme Court held in and for the County of New York, bearing date the 23rd day of May, 1927, in a proceeding therein entitled, in the matter of the Application of the Salvation Army for leave to convey its real property located in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina.

And the said The Salvation Army, the grantor herein, its successors and assigns does hereby bind itself and its successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said The Salvation Army, the grantor herein, its successors and assigns, against itself and its successors and assigns lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
