

It is further understood that this easement of fifty feet in width is to be used only during the construction of said pipe line and which the exception of the right of H. N. Slater, his successors, heirs and assigns, to respect pipe line and to make repairs, the owner has the same privileges and rights to cultivate and use the land as he had prior to this agreement.

It is further agreed that in case of future damages to land or crop due from an accident on pipe line, that H. N. Slater his successors heirs and assigns, shall pay all damages.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages for said easement for said pipe line laid.
