 Know all men by these presents, That we, Emma P. Baker, Wm. D. H. Baker, George L. Baker, Will Baker and Hazel B. Cleveland, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other good and valuable considerations to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. J. DeCamp, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. J. DeCamp and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on Enoree River, near Oulman S. K. and fully described as follows: Beginning on a stake in the middle of Enoree River at a point where the center of Rock Creek enters into said river and running thence N. 5° 30' W. four hundred and fifty-five (455) feet to a rock; thence N. 40° W. One hundred and fifteen (115) feet to a stake; thence N. 30° W. One hundred and Seventy-five (175) feet to a stake; thence N. 15° W. Eighty (80) feet to a stake; thence N. 28° W. Sixty (60) feet to a stake; thence N. 45° W. One hundred and ten (110) feet to a stake; thence N. 47° W. One hundred and forty (140) feet to a stake; thence N. 53° W. ninety (90) feet to a stake; thence N. 41° W. eighty-five (85) feet to a stake; thence S. 85° W. Seventy-five (75) feet to a stake; thence N. 15° W. eighty-five (85) feet to a stake; thence N. 11° W. One hundred and ninety (190) feet to a stake; thence N. 38° W. One hundred and twenty-five (125) feet to a stake; thence N. 81° W. Sixty (60) feet to a stake; thence N. 45° W. One hundred and thirty (130) feet to a stake; thence N. 48° 30' W. forty (40) feet to a stake; thence N. 76° W. Seventy (70) feet to a stake; thence N. 42° W. forty-five (45) feet to a stake; thence N. 47° W. One hundred and forty (140) feet to a stake; thence N. 51° W. One hundred and thirty (130) feet to an iron pin in P. T. Compton's line 13.3 feet north-west of P. T. Compton's water line corner; thence with his line S. 85° 15' E. to a point in the middle of the river; thence down the river with its meanderings to the point of beginning; containing 9.2 acres, more or less.

And a part of the consideration of this deed it is agreed between the parties hereto that the timber upon said land is reserved to the

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
