I know ye, all men, by these presents that I, James K. Rodgers, for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education, and support of my grandchild, Ida May Bitchard, of the age of six years, to Otho Gordon Power for and during her minority

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me as grandfather, over and respect to the said Ida May Bitchard.

To have and to hold, the said Ida May Bitchard against me and any and all persons claiming or holding or to claim any interest right, or privilege through me, in and to the said Ida May Bitchard
