

When the pipe line is completed the Company will provide a connection with the same, to wit, a three inch tap, for the town of Marietta, at or near the point where the pipe line crosses the road commonly known as the Key Highway.

In the event of any future damages to land or crops due to an accident on the pipe line the Company shall pay the same.

The land is described as follows: Approximately One thousand Four Hundred and eight feet in length across that certain tract of land at Marietta, S.C. is which is bounded on the North by road leading from Key Highway to Marietta Baptist Church, on the East by North Saluda River, on the South by C.S. Trust and the Key Highway and on the West by C.S. Trust, being the same conveyed to me by J.N. + R.M. Cleveland.

To Have And To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Slater Manufacturing Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said easement unto the Slater Manufacturing Company, its successors and assigns against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.
