Burdett corner); thence N. 35-1/2 W. 18.25 chs. to iron pin in center of Bethel Road; thence along said road S. 49-4 W. 19.14 chs. to iron pin in said road; thence S. 49 E. 2.50 chs. to stone; thence S. 12-1/2 E. 22.30 chs. to small Oak in edge of branch; thence N. 62-3/4 E. 3.70 chs. to Flint rock; thence N. 42-1/2 E. 7.16 chs. to beginning corner, containing 46 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to W.
