

Railway Company, and restore said right of way to its condition existing prior to the construction of said pipes and manholes thereupon; or, in default thereof, the Railway Company may itself remove the same and restore the condition of said right of way, at the expense of the Licensee.

And It is Mutually Conveyed and Agreed:

5. That this agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto, as well as upon the parties themselves.
