Hooper, Mrs. Laura Lee Hylie and Mrs. Abbie Lucie Butler in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one dollar to each of us in hand paid and for other good and sufficient consideration, receipt of which we hereby acknowledge, do name, constitute, and appoint Glenn R. Hooper our Attorney of fact, with full and unlimited power for us to mortgage at his discretion and borrow money on any real estate owned by my father G. T. Hylie at the time of his death and situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and on what we know as the Camp Road, about two miles from the limits of the City of Greenville, containing 12 acres more or less; two lots of land joined by him at his death on Franklin Road, being all the real estate in said County left by him at his death; and we do hereby ratify all acts of the said Glenn Hooper in this connection as such Attorney of fact.
