Ms. Nellie Cook Stewart died, died and possessed) in  
and to the following described real estate;

All that lot of land situated in the State of South  
Carolina, County of Greenville, on the back side of  
Main Street in the Town of Fountain Inn, and  
having the following metes and bounds, to wit:  
beginning at an iron fence post on Main Street,  
going west a distance of 100 feet to said  
post, then measuring a distance of One Hundred Fifty  
feet and one-half (156 1/2) feet from the corner be-  
tween Mrs. J. C. Martin's lot and Mrs. Nellie Cook's lot,  
Main Street, running thence from said iron fence
