KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I (or we) John J. Woodside, President Woodside Cotton Mills Company in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me (or us) in hand paid, and other valuable consideration at and before sealing and delivering hereof, by the State Highway Commission, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release, unto the said State Highway Commission, its successors and assigns.

A right-of-way sufficiently wide to construct the road as planned, and not less than Twenty-five (25) feet wide on each side of center line of road, on and over all lands, lying along the road, known, as Route No. 21 at any point or points lying between the Greenville Name of Place

and N. E. Line Name of Place which I (or we) may own in whole or in part, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said highway, with the bridges and causeways thereon.

*Provided the State Highway Commission shall move without cost to owners and leave in good condition all buildings adjacent to said road which may be affected by the changing or widening of the road. New location for buildings which may be moved to be designated by owners.*

Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident to or appertaining. It is agreed that any buildings or fences to be moved from the right of way will be moved at the expense of said County or State.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said right of way and the rights hereinbefore granted, unto the said State Highway Commission, its successors and assigns, so long as the same shall be used as part of the highway system of this State or Nation.

A right-of-way sufficiently wide to construct the road as planned, and not less than Twenty-five (25) feet wide on Right-East side of center line of road, on and over all lands, lying along the road, known, as Route No. 21 at any point or points lying between the Travelers Rest Name of Place

and N. E. Line Name of Place which I (or we) may own in whole or in part, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said highway, with the bridges and causeways thereon.

Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident to or appertaining. It is agreed that any buildings or fences to be moved from the right of way will be moved at the expense of said County or State.
