

at its own expense, change the location of said pipe line so that the same shall not interfere with the work of the Railway Company or its use of its said Railway tracks and other property. Fourth: That it will indemnify and save the Railway Company harmless from and against any and all loss of or damage to property of the Railway Company, and against any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments or sums of money accruing to the Licensee or to any person, firm or corporation against the Railway Company for any injury or damage caused in any manner whatsoever resulting either to person or property arising or growing out of the location of said pipe line upon the right of way of the Railway Company.

Fifth: The Licensee agrees to pay to the Railway Company the expenses of its representative in supervising the laying of said pipe line, promptly upon receipt of bill rendered by the Railway Company therefor.

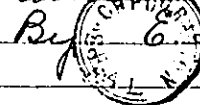
