2. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in section known as Park Place, and being a small portion of Lot No. 5, Block A, as shown on plat said small portion being near the middle of said lot, fronting 10 feet on Lot No. 4, and 12 feet deep, with parallel side lines.
