Received of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, Incorporated, Five + 7/100 Dollars, in consideration of which we hereby grant unto said Company, its Successors and Assigns, the right, privilege and Authority to Construct, operate and maintain one course or line of Telephone and Telegraph poles, in the location now designated by small Stakes including the necessary wires and fixtures thereon and in addition thereto, the further right to erect and set the necessary guy wires, brace poles and Anchors and attach thereto the necessary guy wires incident to the erection, operation and maintenance of said pole line upon, over and across the property which we own, or in which we have an interest, in the Township of Bates, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina and upon the following terms and Conditions to-wit:

1. The Telephone Company reserves the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other Company or person to said poles and fixtures and in addition thereto shall have the right to trim and cut trees along said pole line so as to clear and keep the wires thereof cleared at least 50 feet on each side of line.

2. The Telephone Company agrees to at all time to protect, indemnify and save the property owner harmless from any and all losses by the operation and maintenance of said pole line, and said property growing out of the negligence of its employees or agents.

3. At the request of the undersigned, the Telephone Company will relocate and reconstruct its line of poles, wires and fixtures to a suitable location on said property to accommodate future roads, street improvements and the construction of buildings.
