Whereas, M. B. Priest and L. D. Patterson executed and delivered to Title Guarantee and Trust Company a deed dated March 27, 1923, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Meane Conveyances for said County and styled in Deed Book 85, at page 478; conveying to said Company certain lands (including the plots herein after described) in trust to sell and dispose of the same; and

Whereas, said Company as Trustee, has disposed of portions of the lands, but has not sold or contracted to sell the lots herein after enumerated; and

Whereas, it is now desired to terminate the Trust as to the lands herein after described by reconveying the same to the said former Owners thereof;

Now, Therefore, know all men by these Presents that the said Title Guarantee and Trust Company a corporation, in consideration of the Premium and in further consideration of the sum of One Dollar to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the said former Owners of the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto M. B. Priest all those fourteen (14) certain lots, pieces and parcels of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina (in Greenville County and Township about three and one-fourth (3 1/4) miles South-eastward from Greenville Court House, known and designated respectively, as lots numbered fifty-six (56), fifty seven (57), fifty eight (58), fifty nine (59), sixty (60), one hundred (100), one hundred and one (101), one hundred and fifty four (154), one hundred fifty five (155), one hundred fifty six (156), one hundred fifty seven (157), one hundred seventy seven (177), one hundred and seventy eight (178), and one hundred and seventy nine (179) on the plat of "Marshall Forest" made by Walton & Neaves, dated October 1928, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Meane Conveyances for said County and State on November 8, 1928 in plat Book H, at pages 133, and 134, and having such respective metes and bounds as are shown on said plat.
