Know All Men By These Presents, that I, the said Susan Vaughan, do hereby cancel, revoke and declare the said Power of Attorney, and all provisions thereof, hereinabove referred to, executed by me in favor of Agnes Burdette Johnson (now Mitchell), null, void and of no effect what soever, and the said Agnes Burdette Johnson (now Mitchell) has neither now or at any time in the future any power, right or authority to act for me or in my stead in matters pertaining to my interest in the estate of J. W. Silveath, or in any matter or on any account whatsoever, and I do hereby discharge as my Attorney in fact, and

Notice is hereby given that she has no power or authority to act for me or in my stead under said Power of Attorney in any manner whatsoever.
