 cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from  
 time to time require, upon, across, over and /or under the property which I own or in which  
 I have any interest in the township, of Paris Mountain, county of Greenville, and state of  
 S. C. and upon and along the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property, with  
 the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and  
 cables cleared at least thirty six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and /or  
~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company; and with the  
 further right to cut down and to keep out down all trees and undergrowth within 50 feet of  
 said line. The grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby  
 covenants that no wire line will be erected or permitted on said property which in the  
 judgment of the grantee, its successors and assigns, will interfere with its service or en-  
 danger its lines and that no inflammable structure will be erected or permitted on said  
 property within 50 feet of said lines. Said sum being received in full payment for the  
 rights herein granted.

The Telephone Company will be responsible for damages done to crops or lands dur-  
 ing the construction and maintenance of said pole line growing out of the negligence  
 of its employees or agents.
