 the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property; said sum is received in full
 payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires or
 any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut all
 trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 35 feet, and the
 right to cut all trees that in falling would reach the wires, and the further right to erect
