C. and upon and along the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property; said sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 5 feet and the right to cut all trees that in falling would reach the wires, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brane poles and anchors, and to attach thereto and to tress the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor.

The Telephone Company agrees to rearrange its poles and fixtures, on said property to according to date future building improvements.

\$50.00 Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, Incorporated, Fifty and no/100 Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees, and agents, the right, privilege and authority to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain one course or line of poles in the location now designated by small stakes and including the necessary wires, cables, anchors, other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantees may from time to time require upon, across and over the property which I own or in which I have an interest in the County of Greenville, and State of S. C. upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1 The Telephone Company reserves the right to permit the attachment of wires of any other company or person to said poles, and in addition thereto shall have the right to trim and cut trees along said pole line so as to clear and keep the wires thereon cleared at least 5 feet on each side of line.

2. The Telephone Company agrees to at all times to protect, indemnify and save the property owner harmless from any and all losses by the operation and maintenance of said pole line, on said property growing out of the negligence of its employees or agents.

3. The Telephone Company agrees to relocate and reconstruct its line to a suitable location on said property without cost to the property owner, to accommodate future roads, streets and the construction of buildings; said sum received in full payment for the rights and privileges as above stated.
