brother's estate and effects, to which  
I am entitled as his sister, under  
the statutes for the distribution of  
the personal estate of intestates,  
and upon receipt thereof for me  
and in my name, to give good and  
effectual releases and discharges  
to the administrator or administrators  
of my deceased brother and also for  
me, and in my name, and to my  
use, to settle and adjust with the said  
administrator or administrators, any  
accounts, agreements or compositions  
in about or concerning my said  
distributive share of other matter or  
thing in relation thereto, and all  
and whatsoever my said attorney shall  
lawfully do or cause to be done, in  
or about the premises, I do hereby rat-  
ify and confirm.

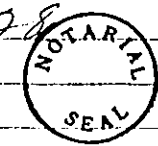
