Whereas on the plat of property as to D. Talley recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, page 116, there is shown a ten foot alley bounding Lots Nos. T-18, T-19, T-20 and T-21 on the north,

and whereas it is the desire of the owners of the property abutting on said alley to close the said alley so that the land contained in the alley and shown on said plat shall become a part of the lots above enumerated so that Lot No. T-18 shall have an additional frontage on Bennett Street of ten feet, and Lots Nos. T-19, T-20 and T-21 shall each have an additional depth of ten feet, and that said alley shall remain closed forever.

It is therefore, in consideration of the premises and the benefit of additional frontage or depth, to our respective lots as above set forth, we the undersigned, being the owners of property abutting said alley, hereby consent and agree to the closing of said alley, which said alley is hereafter to remain closed.
