Know All Men By These Presents That I, C. D. Rhew, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Army Rhew (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Army Rhew,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State S.C., known and designated as lot no. 2 on plat of land of Estate of George H. Marshall, deceased, made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, February 7, 1922, recorded in Plat Book 7, page 57, said land being about 1 1/2 miles north west of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and having the following meters and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Hampton Avenue Extension (which pin is 8.9 feet from the edge of the concrete road) corner of lot no. 3, and running thence with lot no. 3 N. 50-52 E. 125 feet to iron pin in line of lot no. 4; thence with line of said lot N. 39-08 W. 57.5 feet to iron pin, corner of lot no. 1; thence with line of said lot S. 50-52 W. 125 feet to iron pin on Hampton Ave.; thence with Hampton Avenue S. 39-08 E. 57.5 feet to beginning corner.

Also that other lot of land, known and designated as lot no. 3 on plat above referred to, in Township, County and State aforesaid, having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Patterson Street and Hampton Avenue Extension (which pin is 8.9 feet from the edge of the concrete road) and running thence with the north side of Patterson Street N. 50-52 E. 125 feet to corner of lot no. 4; thence with line of said lot N. 39-08 W. 57.5 feet to iron pin, corner of lot no. 2; thence with line of lot no. 2 S. 50-52 W. 125 feet to iron pin on Hampton
