unto the said Amanda Gosnell, her heirs and assigns,  
all of our undivided right, title and interest as heirs  
at law of J. F. Bridgeman, dec'd, of in and to all that  
lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid  
and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at Sherman Mr. Clues  
corner on the North side of the Spartanburg-Asheville  
Highway and run thence N. 16. E. 382.1 feet to stake;  
thence S. 67.55 E. 171 feet to stake corner of J. Ed.  
Bridgeman's land; thence S. 16 W. 382.1 feet to iron pin  
on said Highway; thence along said Highway N. 67.55 W.  
171 feet to the beginning containing 1.5 Acres, more  
or less, and being part of the land owned by our  
father J. F. Bridgeman and which he sold before  
his death to the grantee but died before making the  
deed.
