(b) That lot beginning at a stake on the east side of Westfield Street sixty-five (65) feet southward from West Washington Street (being the southwest corner of the lot conveyed by me to Gulf Refining Company by deed dated February 23, 1923 and recorded in said office in Deed Book 87, at page 316; said lot being fully shown on Plat Book 7, at page 101); measuring thence along said Westfield Street S. 21° N. one hundred and thirty-three (133) feet to a stake on corner of the Nettie Lee Library lot; thence along line of said lot S. 67° E. seventy-three (73) feet to a stake; thence N. 74 1/2° E. one hundred and thirty (130) feet, more or less, to a stake on the southeast corner of the lot conveyed by me to Gulf Refining Company, as aforesaid; thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 64° E. eighty-one and one-tenth (81.1) feet to the beginning corner. This lot (upon which two buildings are situated and which has been described as consisting of two separate lots in mortgages heretofore given by me) includes all which I now own of the lot conveyed to my late husband, J.
