All that certain lot of land situate in said City, County and State fronting one hundred (100) feet on the East side of South Main Street and running back one hundred (100) feet along the South side of Canble Street, consisting of lots numbered one (1) to five (5) inclusive, on R. C. Dalton's plat of the Canble property, recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "F", at page 222.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to this grantor (by the name of "The Norwood National Bank of Greenville S. C.") by the heirs and devisees of the late Henry A. Canble by four deeds, all dated February 9, 1924, and recorded in said office in Deed Book 99, at pages 42, 43 and 44, and in Deed Book 102, at page 59, respectively. It is also referred to in an agreement among said Bank, C. F. Jones, Jr., and L. O. Patterson, dated December 23, 1924, and recorded in said office in Deed Book 100, at page 367.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee herein above named, and its successors and assigns, <sup>forever</sup> in trust, however, to hold the legal title to said property for the benefit of said L. O. Patterson and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and to convey the same as a whole or in parcels to such person or persons, at such time or times and upon such terms as may be requested by said L. O. Patterson, or his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns upon payment of any sums which may then be owing to said Bank by said L. O. Patterson, or his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns.
