## Agreement.

This Agreement made this 7th day of May, 1929, by and between Merritt J. Worley, hereinafter called the husband, and Mrs. Grace Worley, hereinafter called the wife, Witness:

Whereas, disputes have arisen between the said husband and wife on account of which they are separating and intend to forever live separate and apart during the remainder of their natural life.

Now, therefore, in settlement, adjustment, and in compromise of all property questions and rights, the said husband does hereby assign, convey, transfer and set over unto the said wife all household furniture in the residence now occupied by her, as well as automobile or automobiles now owned by the said husband. Also the store now operated by the said husband on Buncombe Street, near the American Spinning Company, including all stock, fixtures, equipment, delivery trucks and any and all property used in connection with the conducting of said store belonging to the said husband to be hers, the said wife as her own separate and distinct property, now and forever. Also the home in which the said wife lives has been this day by proper deed conveyed by the said husband to the said wife as consideration for the above, the said wife does hereby release and forever discharge the said husband from any and all obligations of support and from all claims, rights and duties arising out of said marital relation. Said wife is hereby given full authority to dispose of as she sees fit, any and all of the aforementioned property, and each party is hereby forever barred from any and all rights in any future acquired property by either of the parties hereto, by way of dower, descent, inheritance or distribution.

It is the purpose of this agreement to separate forever the parties hereto, relieving each from the other of all criminal or civil responsibility.

In consideration of the foregoing, the wife above mentioned does hereby assume custody of the children born as the result of said marriage and she does hereby assume full responsibility for the proper care, maintenance, education and support of said children.
