Whereas E. H. Freeman and Nellie Boland Freeman, husband and wife, having been married on the 3rd day of April, 1929, and

whereas the said relationship as husband and wife has been mutually disarranged and has become so disarranged as to be untenable, and both parties aforesaid have become convinced that it is necessary and desirable to have a final settlement and adjustment of all property, interests, rights and claims, the one against the other, growing out of said relation as husband and wife, and to finally separate and cease to live together or to have any relation or association as husband and wife, henceforth and forever.

Now, therefore, the said parties, in view of the conditions and considerations hereinbefore set forth and being fully advised of all rights, claims and demands, which they and each of them may have, the wife against the husband and the husband against the wife, and after consultation and advice with attorneys, respectively, and being convinced that it is to their interest mutually to settle finally and forever all claims, the one against the other, now and forever, do hereby solemnly agree and bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, to the following articles of agreement and covenant, to-wit:

1) In consideration of the foregoing conditions and circumstances and in view of the admitted fact that the said parties cannot now live congenially as husband and wife, the said Nellie Boland Freeman, on her part, does hereby forever release and discharge the said E. H. Freeman, his heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, from all liability, past, present and future, for account of alimony, maintenance or support, and does hereby fully, freely and voluntarily release the said E. H. Freeman, from all present, past or prospective liability, in any manner to her, as husband, and the said Mrs. Nellie Boland Freeman, being privately and separately examined, and in consideration of Five (\$5) Dollars to her in hand paid at and before the sealing of this instrument, does hereby renounce and relinquish unto the
