 and other valuable considerations to the said land
 paid at and before the sealing of these Presents
 by A. M. Owen, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
 have granted, bargained, sold and released, and
 by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said A. M. Owen, his heirs and assigns
 forever.

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land
 situate, lying and being in the County and State
 aforesaid on the South side of the Extension
 of Washington Road and being more fully described
 as follows:—

Lot no. 5 Block "C" of the Mauldin & Cagle Property
 as shown on Plat of the same, which said Plat
 was made by F. H. & J. D. Cunningham, May
 1st, 1919, said lot fronting on Cagle Street distance
 of seventy feet and running back on Parallel
 Alley a distance of one hundred fifty feet to an
 alley, and being part of the lots conveyed by C.
 Montgomery, Master to Oscar K. Mauldin and Henry
 K. Townes. See R. M. C. Book 59, Page 40, see also
 deed made by Oscar Mauldin and Henry K. Townes
 to Addie May Owen, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of
 land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville
 County and State aforesaid, on the north side
 of Cagle Street and having the following metes

Beginning at an iron pin on said Cagle Street
 232.5 feet from the intersection of Cagle Street
 with Maple Street; thence in a northerly
 direction, a distance of 150 feet to an alley; thence
 N. 42-57 W. 70 feet; thence in a southerly direction
 parallel with the first line a distance of 150
 feet to a pin on Cagle Street; thence S. 42-57 E.
