Know all men by these presents, that  
Wattre Power Company, a corporation duly organized  
and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the  
State of South Carolina, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Five (5) Dollars, and other valuable  
considerations to it in hand paid by Duke Power  
Company, a corporation duly organized and existing  
under and by virtue of the laws of the State of  
New Jersey, at and before the signing and sealing  
of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, he  
leased, set over, and delivered, and by these  
presents does grant, bargain, sell, release, set  
over, and deliver unto Duke Power Company, its  
successor and assigns, all those certain trans-  
mission <sup>lines</sup> hereinafter described, including all  
poles towers wires, insulators, rights of way  
and all property of rights of whatsoever nature  
constituting a part or parcel of the said  
transmission lines, now owned by the party  
of the first part, lying and being in the County  
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and de-  
scribed and designated as follows:

1. - A 22,000 volt, single circuit line extending  
from Fountain Dam to Simpsonville, 5 miles in  
length
2. - A 22,000 volt, single circuit line extending  
from Simpsonville to Conster, 7 miles in  
length.
3. - A 22,000 volt, single circuit line known as  
the Hoodia Mill Tap, about 300 feet in length

Being the same property granted and con-  
veyed by the Enore Power Company to the Broad  
River Power Company by deed dated October  
25, 1926, and recorded in Book 128 page 46  
and by the Broad River Power Company to  
the Wattre Power Company by deed dated  
July 29, 1927, and recorded in Book 142  
page 56, in the office of the R M C. for  
Greenville County South Carolina, being in the  
last named deed described under item No 4,  
to which reference is hereby made.
