Second Tract: That lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as Lots nos 5 and 6 in Block "D.W." of the lands of Riverside Land Company according to Plat recorded in the P.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book "A", Page 323, said lots fronting 80 feet more or less on Colonial Avenue and running back 125 feet to an alley, being the same Property conveyed to the Great Falls Power Company by deed of Sarah C. Isaac dated September 7th, 1926, recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville County in Vol. 115, Page 468. Subject to the restrictions and conditions set out in the abovesaid deed from Sarah C. Isaac.

Third Tract: That certain lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, South Carolina, near Monaghan mill company, being a part of the lands known as Riverside, and being Lot no. 5 in Block "C.C." according to Plat recorded in Plat Book "A" at Page 323, fronting 65 feet on Colonial Avenue with a depth of 131.4 feet on Chiora Avenue and being on the corner of said Avenues.

Fourth Tract: That certain lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, South Carolina near Monaghan mill, being part of the Riverside Land Company land known as part of Lot no. 4 of Block "C.C." shown on Plat recorded in P.M.C. Fifth Tract: That lot of land lying in Greenville Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known as Lot no. 1 in Block "C.C." of Riverside according to plat of same in P.M.C. Office of said County in Plat Book "A" at Page 323, having a frontage of 100 feet on Chiora Avenue, and running back a distance of 137 feet along the north side of the alley to the

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right-of-way of the Street car line; reference to said Plat being made for a more definite description. Being the same Property conveyed to Great Falls Power Company by deed of H. K. Townsend dated September 11th 1926, and recorded in the Public Registry of said County in Vol. 118 at Page 470 subject to the conditions and restrictions set out in said deed from H. K. Townsend.

Sixth Parcel: The right, Privilege and easement of construction, maintaining and operating electric transmission lines upon, over and across those tracts of land located in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, now or formerly belonging to Victor Monaghan Company, Riverside Land Company, J. L. Whittkamp, Union Bleachery Company, J. F. Guin and A. S. Newt, which rights, Privileges and easements are set out and described in the following deeds, all of which are duly recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville County, to-wit: Deed from Victor Monaghan Company to Southern Power Company dated October 5, 1926, recorded in Book 95 at Page 91; deed from Riverside Land Company to Southern Power Company dated January 17, 1927, recorded in Book 95 at Page 145; deed from J. L. Whittkamp to Southern Power Company dated January 21, 1927, recorded in Book 95 at Page 446; deed of Union Bleachery Company to Southern Power Company dated January 17, 1927, recorded in Book 95, at Page 144; deed of J. F. Guin to Southern Power Company dated January 14, 1927, recorded in Book 95, at Page 143; deed of Southern Power Company to Duke Power Company dated December 19, 1927, recorded in Book 141 at Page 47, and deed of A. S. Newt to Duke Power Company dated March 29, 1928, recorded in Book 145 at Page 2, to which deeds reference is hereby made for a more particular description of the rights and easements hereinabove referred to.
