the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

G. H. Greene, the following described real estate, all that tract of land, situate in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, eleven miles northwest of the City of Greenville, on the McElhenny Road, bounded by lands of James Whitman, Walter West, and others, containing 59 3/4 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to B. C. Hudson by Lattie C. Hughes by deed dated Oct 8, 1925, and conveyed to Highland Securities Corporation by E.
